Dear Parents/ carers

**Harvest:** The Resound Foodbank no longer require donations from us for their foodbank, so this year's Harvest will have a different collection. Owls class are leading our Harvest celebrations and they have chosen to raise money for Save the Children. They would like to invite your children to wear **non-school uniform (Friday 28th September)** and for everyone to **bring in your 'coppers'** (1pence and 2pence pieces) and donate them to our collection. We will also be sharing a harvest loaf and watching Owls class assembly.

**Homework:** Following a whole school consultation we have changed the home learning activities which we would like the children to do. Firstly, we would like the children to read as often as they possibly can—preferably a minimum of 5x per week, and for this to be recorded in their reading diaries. There will also be times tables or number bonds and spellings to practice which will be tested in school. For Year 5 & 6 there will also be grammar and maths homework to complete. Instead of the learning jigsaw, for children in Y1 -Y6 there will be a project for the children to do over the course of up to 5 weeks. We hope this enables the children to follow their interests linked to what they are doing in school, and that homework overall supports everyone's learning.

**Ofsted:** Don't forget, we will be holding a coffee morning to discuss our report and answer any questions you may have on Thursday 4th October at 9.00am. A further session will be held on Monday 8th October at 6.30pm. It would be lovely to see you at one of these sessions!

**House points:** This year we will continue to count house points weekly, but we will also be having a termly count. The house with the most points each term will be rewarded with a non-uniform day. (Each term will start afresh to make this fair)


