(I came, I saw, I conquered)



Writing

Our English work will still be linked to our key text called Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit and Romans. We will be writing a persuasive letter, as well as other types of writing.

Reading

We will have guided reading sessions this term where we will be reading a selection of fiction and non fiction texts.

Please ensure you hear your child read frequently at home. Reading record books will be checked when books are changed and during a guided reading session to monitor your child's reading at home. These record books are for you, as well as your child, to write any comments in.



Maths

We will be studying length and perimeter, telling the time, comparing sec, mins, hours and duration of time and calculating change .

It will greatly help your child if you **regularly practice telling the time at home**, both on analogue and digital clocks.

Please encourage your child to talk about the maths they have been doing in school.



PE

This term our PE will focus on invasion games (tag rugby) and dance. The children will need their PE kits in school every day. Long hair must be tied back and **earrings removed**. Weather permitting, games will take place outside so trainers or daps will be needed and black, navy or grey jogging bottoms can be worn if necessary.



Topic

This term our topic is called 'VENI, VIDI, VICI (I came, I saw, I conquered)'. In History, we will continue to study The Roman Empire and its impact upon Britain. We will also be doing Geography by comparing modern Rome and Bristol in relation to the cities and physical aspects (eg weather) and looking at how earthquakes and volcanoes occur. In Science, we will be studying forces and magnets.
