

The zig zag markings are there to keep our children safe—please do NOT park on them. We would be grateful if parents could park with care and consideration for both our children and the local residents.

### Car Park

Despite requests to not use the staff car park, several parents are still using the car park to drop off/pick up children at the beginning and end of the school day.
